



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## TELE – how does it develop?

TELE, standing for „**TEACHING ENTREPRENEURSHIP – LEARNING ENTREPRENEURSHIP**“, is a project funded as part of the European educational program ERASMUS+ and includes partner organizations from Germany, Iceland, Latvia, Spain and Romania. The project started in September 2014 and it will finish in June 2016 with a final conference in Spain.

### *Analysing phase*

The first half of 2015 meant a lot of **research** work on the part of the five partners in the TELE project. All team members of the partnership dedicated themselves to producing an analysis regarding entrepreneurship, data about the rate of unemployment in their countries, approaches and best practices in teaching entrepreneurship, but also information about political strategies to foster entrepreneurship. The greatest challenge for the partners of this project is to find the best methods of teaching and encouraging entrepreneurship with target groups facing social disadvantages, which can then be applied in and adapted to five countries with completely different economic and cultural backgrounds. The final goal of the project is to identify and develop approaches and methods that will facilitate a better access to the labour market for young unemployed people or students considering dropping out of school.

We have successfully carried out the first major task of the activities set for the TELE project, namely the analysis and collection of existing materials and good practice examples in the participating countries and in Europe. The following activity is the creation and finalization of three different concepts for entrepreneurship workshops with corresponding course material, which is going to be tested and evaluated by trainers and teachers from all partner countries in October 2015 in Iceland.

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## The second meeting in Onesti, Romania

The second meeting of the TELE project took place at the office of AMICII COLEGIULUI 'PETRU PONI' in Onesti, Romania on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> of June 2015.

All partners presented their researches/analyses about unemployment and entrepreneurship approaches, as well as best practices of entrepreneurship teaching in their countries. We worked on the finalization of the three teaching modules and discussed further details of the Trainer Workshop in Iceland. We were also introduced to the methods practiced in Romania. We established the next steps to be taken in the project, and we allocated further tasks to be accomplished.
